WHAT INFORMATION DO I NEED TO APPLY FOR LIHEAP? YOU MAY NEED THE FOLLOWING:

- Recent copies of your utility bills.
- A recent payroll stub or other proof that shows your current gross income.
- Documentation showing income from Social Security, Unemployment Insurance, Pension Funds, disability, etc.
- Final Utility Termination Notice (if you've received a shut-off notice from your energy company).
- Proof of present address (e.g., rent receipt, lease or deed, property tax bill).
- Proof of total members living in your household (e.g., birth certificates, school records, etc.).
- Social Security cards (or numbers) for all persons living in your household.

Proof of U.S. citizenship or permanent residence.

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

Share the Warmth

Administered for North Shore Gas by the Community Action Partnership of Lake County, Share the Warmth provides heating grants to limited and fixed-income households. Eligible customers can receive grants of up to \$200 on their bills.

How can I apply for a Share the Warmth grant?

Call the <u>Community Action Partnership of Lake County</u> at 847-249-4330 to make an appointment to apply. Applicants are required to submit:

- Proof of household income or any financial assistance for the past 30 days for all members of the household aged 18 or older.
- Your current residential heating bill.
- Proof of indentification.

Who is eligible?

North Shore Gas customers who are having trouble paying their bills and meet the following household income guidelines may be eligible for a grant.

Los clientes elegibles que realizan un abono para saldar sus facturas reciben subsidios equivalentes de hasta \$200.

¿Cómo puedo solicitar un subsidio de Comparta el calor?

Llame a la Asociación de <u>Acción Comunitaria del Condado de Lake</u> al 847-249-4330 para hacer una cita para aplicar . Los solicitantes deben presentar:

- Prueba de ingresos del hogar o cualquier tipo de asistencia financiera durante los últimos 30 días para todos los miembros del hogar mayores de 18 años.
- Su actual factura de la calefacción residencial.
- Prueba de identificación.

¿Quiénes reúnen los requisitos?

Los clientes de North Shore Gas que tienen dificultades para pagar sus facturas y cumplen con las siguientes normas de ingresos del hogar pueden reunir los requisitos para un subsidio.
