Is looking for an alternative to a nursing home or assisted living facility?



If so, the **VA Medical Foster Home Program** may be an option for you!

What is a Medical Foster Home (MFH)?

MFHs provide a safe, supportive, long-term care option for Veterans in a comfortable home environment. It may be appropriate for those who need nursing home care but prefer a non-institutional setting with fewer residents. Veterans living in a MFH are required to receive health care services from the Lovell FHCC Home Based Primary Care (HBPC) team.

While Lovell FHCC helps coordinate care, MFHs are not currently provided or paid for by Veterans Affairs. Cost for the MFH is the responsibility of the Veteran. The charge for a MFH varies based on income and the level of care needed. The specific cost is agreed upon by the Veteran and the MFH caregiver ahead of time.

- ✓ Choice of homemade meals & snacks
