

Moraine Township Offers Help Enrolling for 2024 Health Insurance on the Federal Marketplace Open Enrollment November 1, 2023 through January 15, 2024

Moraine Township is offering assistance to residents wishing to enroll for 2024 health insurance on the Federal Marketplace under the Affordable Care Act.

Trained and certified counselors are available to work one-on-one with residents to help them understand their options, balance their medical needs and budgets, compare coverage and costs, and ensure that enrollees receive the premium subsidies and cost-sharing reductions they may be income-qualified for.

Residents who are currently enrolled in health insurance plans through the Marketplace can re-enroll in their existing plan for another year, or select a new plan. A Counselor will help enrollees learn about changes that may have taken place in their existing plan, or review details and compare costs of alternative plans.

Help With Medicare Part D for Moraine Township Residents

Moraine Township offers a free service to **Moraine Township** residents to help sign up for Medicare Part D. Each year you might want to evaluate Medicare Prescription Drug Plans to determine which best suits your current needs based on the medications you are on.

We are taking appointments from **October 16 through December 6**; new plans take effect January 1, 2024.
