Two important announcements:

1) FLAP has one-time \$500 cash transfer for very low-income Latino undocumented individuals who a) live in the following counties and cities: Boone, Lake, Ogle, Stephenson and Winnebago Counties, Aurora, Batavia, Berwyn, Cicero, Evanston, Maywood, Montgomery, Oak Park, River Forest **and** b) work in these industries: Food industry, Restaurants, bakery, coffeehouse, landscaping, snow plowing, packinghouse, cannery, farms, nursery, greenhouse, meat and poultry. (We are particularly interested in helping those in the agricultural and landscaping industries).

2) FLAP has one-time \$500 cash transfer for very low-income Latino undocumented individuals who live in Illinois. In order to receive the funding, they **MUST** attend a Know Your Rights ZOOM meeting presentation to learn about their rights at work. FLAP has to schedule the presentations by June 10th.
