1. LIHEAP The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) helps eligible low-income households pay for home energy services (primarily heating during winter months).

2. IL Home Weatherization Assistance (IWAP) helps low income residents and households conserve fuel and reduce energy costs by making their homes and apartments more energy efficient. IHWAP also provides many health and safety upgrades ensuring safe and healthy homes.

3. Energy-saving Products including smart thermostats, LED lighting and advanced power strips, significantly reduce utility bills and consumption.

4. PowerMarket Community Solar Community solar provides residents with the benefits of clean energy without the hassle of traditional solar panel installation. Powermarket connects your ComEd account to a Yomen solar project in Waukegan, IL in a few, simple steps. Or, to another IL solar farm if you live outside Waukegan.

5. Citizens Utility Board (CUB) CUB's Outreach Team staffs hundreds of free events a year, running statewide campaigns to educate people on how to reduce and read their utility bills, covering such topics as energy efficiency, solar power, cable bills, water privatization and clean energy legislation.

6. 7. Illinois Low-Income Discount Rates: Natural Gas and Electric The Low-Income Discount Rates provide a monthly discount on natural gas bills from Nicor Gas, North Shore Gas customers and a monthly discount on electric bills from ComEd customers with qualifying household incomes.

8. CLEAN POWER LAKE COUNTY (CPLC) Clean Power Lake County is a community-driven nonprofit organization committed to local action to secure environmental, economic, and racial justice.
