Documentation of Eligibility

This form documents your eligibility to receive a free laptop computer through the Lake County Digital Growth Initiative. The goal of this Program is to provide eligible households with laptop computers so that the household can connect to the internet. The funding for this program comes from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund awarded to Lake County. The rules and requirements for the use of these funds are set by the US Treasury. They limit eligibility to households who meet one of the following criteria. Please mark all that apply:
