Lake County's 211 Reaches 150,000 Contacts Milestone!

This month, United Way of Lake County's 211 reached a major milestone of 150,000 contacts by phone and online, reinforcing its vital role as Lake County's one-stop shop for help. Since its launch in September 2019, 211 has made more than 150,000 connections to help from every zip code in Lake County, mostly for help with housing and shelter, rent and utility assistance, food, health care, mental health resources and addictions.

211 is an easy to remember, three-digit number that connects people to expert, caring help, including the best local resources. The information and referral service accesses a database of more than 1,500 health and human service organizations serving our community, as well as federal, state and local aid.

211 is multilingual with English and Spanish speaking staff, and a professional 24-hour phone interpretation service for over 150 languages. Two-way texting is available in English and Spanish. 211 is always open, always confidential, and always free.

Anyone needing help in Lake County can connect to 211 by dialing **2-1-1**, texting their zip code to **898211** or visiting **211LakeCounty.org**.

988 SUICIDE & CRISIS

988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline

On July 16, 2022, the U.S. will transition to using 988—the three-digit dialing code for the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline—a first step toward strengthening and transforming crisis care in this country. It serves as a universal entry point so that no matter where you live, you can reach a trained crisis counselor who can help.

988 is a direct connection to compassionate, accessible care and support for anyone experiencing mental health-related distress—whether that is thoughts of suicide, mental health or substance use crisis, or any other kind of emotional distress. People can also dial 988 if they are worried about a loved one who may need crisis support.

988 is confidential, free and available 24/7 in English and Spanish, along with interpretation services in over 150 languages.

How is 988 different than 211? 211 provides information and referrals for a wide range of health and human services. 988 crisis counselors provide support for people in suicidal or mental health-related distress in the very moments they need it most. While different in scope, these systems will work to align and coordinate to provide an all-inclusive approach regardless of which number a person may use first.
