If you are looking for information, support or access to mental health resources, **call 211 or text your zip code to 898-211** to connect with a caring person who can help guide you. 211 is always available with English and Spanish-speaking support and interpretation to more than 150 languages.

If you or someone you know is struggling with thoughts of suicide or experiencing a mental health or substance use crisis, call or text 988 or chat <u>988lifeline.org</u> to reach a trained crisis counselor, 24/7.

211 and 988 conversations are completely confidential. Help is here. Talk to someone.

Always call 911 first if you or someone you love is experiencing a life-threatening medical emergency or may be a danger to someone else.
