Caller Story

Jean, a single senior woman, reached out to 211 asking for "any type of assistance." The 211 expert navigator conducted an assessment and learned Jean needed help with her water bill and mortgage payment. Prior to calling 211, Jean had asked a few agencies for help but they were not able to help her.

Jean went on to explain that her bills were more than the social security check she receives every month, and her mortgage payments fluctuate monthly and had been increasing since the beginning of the year. Jean sounded discouraged and worried about her inability to pay her bills and stay in her home. 211 provided Jean with a list of resources and asked if we could follow up with her. She agreed to a follow-up call.

When asked if Jean had any feedback about the 211 service, she answered "It was fantastic! I was so amazed. I'm glad to have programs like this. They really help you out."
